

## Sixth Form Dress Standards (with effect from September 2024)

Bredon Tweed blazer and plain Charcoal (Dark) Grey trousers/skirt

Both of the above are to be paired with a striped blue or pink shirt and house tie. **OR** School prefect/head of school tie as provided by the headmaster.

Optional <u>v-neck</u> pullover in navy, charcoal grey or black can be worn in addition to a blazer, but not in place of.

Black or brown leather shoes, with dark grey or black socks, boots are not acceptable.

- Tweed blazer to be purchased through Stevensons (mens and ladies fit)
- Striped shirt can be purchased through Stevensons, although other alternatives can be sought, as long as the stripes are of the same colour and style.
- Grey trousers can be purchased through Stevensons, although other alternatives can be sought, as long as they are of the same dark charcoal colour.
- Grey skirt can be purchased through Stevensons, although other alternatives can be sought, as long as they are of the same dark charcoal colour. To be of a suitable, professional length i.e. no shorter than to the knee.
- House tie to be purchased through Stevensons
- House pin badge to be provided by house parent
- Hair/facial hair should be trimmed, neat and tidy & not at the extremes of fashion
- If you are unsure, please ask Mr Cradock before purchasing.

## Additional information

If a skirt is to be worn, the shirt may be open necked, and a tie is not required.

If trousers are worn, black or navy blue socks should accompany them.

If skirts are worn, they should be no shorter than a maximum of two fingers' width above the knee. And should be paired with tights.

Tights are to be of plain design and black or navy
