APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable application fee of £150 is payable at the point of submitting school and specialist reports for assessment.

DEPOSITS

An acceptance deposit of £750 is payable by UK residents. For all non-UK residents, the deposit is £7,250. The deposit is refundable on settlement of the final account.

Bredon School SALT packages

UNIVERSAL PROVISION (INCLUDED IN STANDARD FEES)

Universal provision supports all pupils at Bredon School and ensures they can access their learning environment and have appropriate language and communication opportunities.

- Teachers have access to appropriate support and guidance from Inclusion Manager, SENCOs, SLS staff and Speech and Language Therapists
- Bredon School has a communication and language friendly environment
- Use of whole class intervention approaches such as consistent visual support and multisensory learning, as well as using 'Word Aware' as an approach for developing vocabulary skills
- Workforce trained with regards to speech, language and communication on a regular basis and excellent liaison between SALT team and teaching staff.

TARGETED PACKAGES (ADDITIONAL TO STANDARD FEES)

Targeted support is when specific interventions are offered to young people at Bredon School who have some difficulties in relation to speech, language and communication, but with a small amount of directed support, can succeed.

Package T1 - £450 half termly

- Annual assessment, report and targets set (completed by Speech and Language Therapist)
- Half termly in-class support session from Speech and Language Therapist including a mixture of direct and indirect support
- Liaison with school staff/parents to support and offer advice to implement at home and in class.

Package T2 - £330 per term

- Annual assessment, report and targets set (completed by Speech and Language Therapist)
- Termly in-class support session from Speech and Language Therapist including a mixture of direct and indirect support
- Liaison with school staff/parents to support and offer advice to implement at home and in class.

SPECIALIST PACKAGES (ADDITIONAL TO STANDARD FEES)

Specialist support is for those young people at Bredon School who, despite the universal provision, still require highly individualised and personalised support. This may include pupils with complex learning and communication needs or those who although cognitively able have a specific speech, language or communication need.

Package S1 (individual) - £1,200 per term

- Annual assessment, report and targets set (completed by Speech and Language Therapist)
- Direct and indirect support from Speech and Language Therapist (to include a mixture of in-class and out of class support, depending on clinical needs) on a regular basis
- Liaison with school staff/parents to support and offer advice to implement at home and in class.

Package S2 (group) - £540 per term

- Informal assessment, summary findings and targets set (completed by Speech and Language Therapist)
- Direct support from Speech and Language Therapist in a social skills or language group on a regular basis
- Liaison with school staff/parents to support and offer advice to implement at home and in class.
